ORDINANCE NO. 1, 1955

TO PROHIBIT THE DUMPING, DEPOSITING AND ACCUMULATION OF RUBBISH AND/OR GARBAGE UPON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PROHIBITION OR DUMPING, DEPOSITING AND ACCUMULATION OF GARBAGE AND/OR RUBBISH EXCEPT UPON LANDS DESIGNATED AS PUBLIC DUMPS BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

The Board of Supervisors of Buffalo Township, Washington County,

Pa., does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. No owner of land within the limits of said Township shall dump, deposit or accumulate garbage and/or rubbish upon his land nor shall such owner permit, acquiesce in or allow any person, firm or corporation to dump, deposit or accumulate garbage and/or rubbish upon his land.

SECTION 2. No person, firm or corporation shall dump, deposit or accumulate garbage and/or rubbish upon any public or private property within the limits of said Township.

SECTION 3. The Board of Supervisors may designate what public or private property in said Township may be used as a public dump and in the event of such designation the terms of Sections 1 and 2 shall not apply.

SECTION 4. Any owner, person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of Section 1 or 2 hereof shall, for each and every violation, be subject to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment to undergo imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not exceeding fifteen (15) days.
