ORDINANCE AGAINST OBSTRUCTION OF HIGHWAY

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE ERECTION OR CONSTRUCTION OF ANY OBSTRUCTION TO THE CONVENIENT USE OF ROADS, FOOTWALKS, CULVERTS, DRAINS AND BRIDGES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF BUFFALO, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

SECTION 1. The word "person" shall mean a natural person, male or female, partnership, corporation, fiduciary or association. Whenever used in the section imposing a penalty the word "person" as applied to associations or partnerships shall mean the members or partners either individually or collectively.

SECTION 2. No person shall erect or construct any obstruction within the limits of the township roads which will bar the convenient use of said roads, footwalks, culverts, drains and bridges of said Township.

SECTION 3. Any and all persons who willfully or maliciously build, erect or place any obstruction to the convenient use of the said Township roads, footwalks, culverts, drains or bridges shall be responsible for any damage or damages to the traveling public resulting from said obstruction or obstructions.

SECTION 4. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace or Alderman shall be subject to a fine of not in excess of \$100.00 for each offense, and costs, and in default of payment of fine and costs, to be imprisoned in the Washington County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

July 10, 1947, P. L. 1481, 53 P. S. 65726.
