ORDINANCE NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of Buffalo Township, at a meeting to be held on 8th, July 8, 1960 at 8 o'clock, P. M., D.S.T., at the Secretary's Office, R. D. 1, Claysville, Pennsylvania, intend to adopt the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 8

AN ORDINANCE OF BUFFALO TOWNSHIP, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REQUIRING ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMIT BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BUILDINGS AND/OR THE ALTERATION, RECONSTRUCTION, REMODELLING AND REPAIR OF EXISTING BUILDINGS SITUATE WITHIN THE SAID TOWNSHIP, WHERE COST INVOLVED IS IN EXCESS OF \$500.00, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Board of Supervisors of Buffalo Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: No individual, firm, association or corporation shall commence or cause, permit or allow the commencement of the construction of new buildings, and/or the repair, alteration, remodeling or reconstruction of any existing building in this Township where the cost of such repair, alteration, remodeling or reconstruction shall exceed the sum of \$500.00, without first obtaining a permit for same.

SECTION 2: That any individual, firm, association or corporation seeking such a building permit shall pay therefor to the person designated by the Board of Supervisors the sum of \$2.00.

SECTION 3: Any individual, firm, association or corporation violating the provisions hereof shall, for each and every violation thereof, be subject to a fine of not less than \$25.00, and not more than \$100.00, and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof to undergo imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not exceeding 15 days.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective on the 8th day of July, 1960
