Vehicle Weight Limits

ORDINANCE NO. 9 OF 1960

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING THE GROSS WEIGHT LIMITS OF VEHICLES OPERATING OVER CERTAIN ROADS IN BUFFALO TOWNSHIP, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Board of Supervisors of Buffalo Towhip, Washington County, Pennsylvania, does hereby RESOLVE and ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION ONE: No commercial vehicles, trucks, and/or truck tractors, and/or truck trailors or other machinery or equipment with a gross weight exceeding ten (10) tons, shall be used or operated upon Township Road No. 526, lying wholly within the limits of said Township.

SECTION TWO: No commercial vehicles, trucks, and/or truck tractors, and/or truck trailors or other machinery or equipment with a gross weight exceeding ten (10) tons, shall be used or operated upon that portion of Township Road No. 474 lying and being on the Southern side of new United States Route No. 40, and also lying wholly within the limits of said Township.

SECTION THREE: The roadmaster of Buffalo Township shall erect signs limiting or regulating the gross weight limits upon such other roads and highways of the Township as the Supervisors shall, from time to time, by resolution designate.

SECTION FOUR: Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of SECTIONS ONE, TWO or THREE hereof shall, upon summary conviction before a justice of peace or magistrate, for each and every violation thereof, be subject to a fine of not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, to undergo imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not exceeding ten days.
