

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO NOISE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF BUFFALO; prohibiting the making of noise so as to annoy any other person; prohibiting the use of noise in order to attract the attention of other persons for commercial or advertising purposes; requiring that machinery, electrical and mechanical devices be muffled, controlled or insulated as necessary in order to prevent the emission of offensive noise; and prescribing penalties for violation.

THE TOWNSHIP OF BUFFALO, HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The word person as used in this ordinance shall mean any natural person, partnership, firm, association, organization, firm or corporation. The singular shall include the plural and the masculine shall include the feminine and the neuter.

Section 2. No person within the Township of Buffalo shall lawfully make, or cause to be made, any loud, boisterous or unseemly noise or disturbance, to the annoyance of any other person. Provided: nothing contained in this section shall restrict or limit the normal use to be made of parks, recreation places, play-fields and playgrounds in the township.

Section 3. No person shall make or cause to be made or permit to be made, any noise of any kind, by crying, calling or shouting, or by means of any whistle, rattle, gong, horn, drum or similar mechanical device for the purpose of advertising any goods, wares, or merchandise, or of attracting the attention or inviting the patronage of any person to any business whatever, in the Township of Buffalo.

Section 4. No person in the Township shall, for commercial purposes, or in connection with any commercial enterprise, erect or locate any device or apparatus in front of or

on the exterior or premises owned or occupied by him which, by mechanical or electrical means, including any transistorized device or means emits any loud sounds or noises, so as to annoy or disturb passers-by on the street or roads or the general public. Provided: the provisions of this Section shall not apply in time of emergency to any announcement or broadcast of any current event or public interest.

Section 5. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, for each and every offense, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days. Provided: each day's violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect on the ~~20th~~ ⁴ day of ~~May~~ ^{June}, 1965.
