ORDINANCE NO. 11, of 1966

TO PROHIBIT THE DUMPING, DEPOSITING, SPREADING, AND ACCUMULATION OF EXCREMENT, DUNG, FECAL MATTER, FILTH, UPON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PROHIBITION OF DUMPING, DEPOSITING, SPREADING AND ACCUMULATION OF EXCREMENT, DUNG, FECAL MATTER AND FILTH, EXCEPT UPON LANDS DESIGNATED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

The Board of Road Supervisors of Buffalo Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. No owner of land within the limits of said Buffalo Township shall dump, deposit, spread or accumulate excrement, dung, fecal matter and filth upon his land nor shall such owner permit, acquiesce in or allow any person, firm, or corporation to dump, deposit, spread and/or accumulate excrement, dung, fecal matter and filth upon his land.

SECTION 2. No person, firm or corporation shall dump, deposit, spread and accumulate excrement, dung, fecal matter, and filth upon any public or private property within the limits of said Buffalo Township.

SECTION 3. The Board of Road Supervisors may designate what public or private property in said Township may be used and under what conditions the same may be used as a dumping ground and in the event of such designation the terms of Section 1 and Section 2 shall not apply.

SECTION 4. Any owner, person, firm or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof for each and every violation be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars and not more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars, and in default of payment of such fine and costs to undergo imprisonment in the Washington County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect on the
