

ORDINANCE NO. 28 OF 1996

AN ORDINANCE OF BUFFALO TOWNSHIP, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA VACATING TOWNSHIP ROAD T-626 ON THE BASIS THAT THE ROAD HAS BECOME USELESS, INCONVENIENT AND/OR BURDENSOME.

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Buffalo Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania, have been requested to vacate Township Road T-626 on the basis that the road is becoming useless, inconvenient and/or burdensome; and

WHEREAS, the Township has given written notice to the owners of the property adjacent to Township Road T-626 or portions thereof involved of a time and place set for a proposed hearing on the matter which was held at 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, February 6, 1996 at the Township Building, 4340 Route 40, Claysville, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors voted favorably on requests to vacate Township Road T-626;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Supervisors of Buffalo Township, that:


1. Township Road T-626 shall be vacated on the basis that the road has become useless, inconvenient and/or burdensome.


2. A draft or survey of the portion of Township Road T-626 showing its location and width and a copy of this Ordinance shall be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of Washington County.
